

Responsible behaviors for all staff will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teaching and reviewing expected behaviors for all school areas throughout the year • Giving positive feedback when responsible behavior is observed • Responding to misbehaviors consistently • Frequent reference to the Keys to Character • Daily incorporation of our school-wide expectations/procedures 	<p align="center"><u>School-wide Procedures</u></p> <p><i>Playground:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Stay in designated area 2. Use equipment appropriately and safely 3. Do not throw mulch or sand 4. Refrain from rough physical contact <p><i>Cafeteria:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Keep hands, feet, and objects to self 2. Face forward and eat respectfully 3. Stay seated and raise hand for assistance 4. Use proper table manners 5. Use Level 2 Voice 6. Keep restroom clean and use appropriate behaviors 	<p align="center"><u>School-wide Procedures</u></p> <p><i>Hallway:</i></p> <p>Walk safely on the right Always face forwards Level 0 Keep hands and feet to yourself</p> <p><i>Voice Levels:</i></p> <p>4 Outside voice 3 Loud, proud, sharing voice 2 Conversation voice 1 Working whisper 0 Silent</p>
